## Classroom Instruction for New Drivers Offered at AHS

Did you know that in the US, motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for ages 15 – 24? Help your student develop responsible habits that will keep them safe as they reach the very important milestone of becoming a driver. The class can help your student stay focused on the road and build the confidence they'll need when facing dangerous traffic situations. The **Alive at 25** program focuses on these specific areas to help new drivers develop good habits behind the wheel:

- *Why do young drivers often underestimate risk?*
- *What are some important techniques used to maintain control?*
- *How should a driver handle distractions (passengers, cell phones, etc.)?*
- *What responsibilities come with the privilege of driving?*
